Sin Chung Kai is the legislator representing the Information Technology Functional Constituency in Hong Kong. He has been currently the chairman of the Panel on Information Technology and Broadcasting of LegCo since 1998. Outside of the legislature, Sin Chung Kai has served as a member of the Board of Directors of Hong Kong Mortgage Corporation Limited; the Housing Authority and the HKSAR Government's Information Infrastructure Advisory Committee. He also serves on various other advisory boards both in the public and private sector.

Sin Chung Kai is a member of various IT professional societies, including Hong Kong Computer Society, Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers and Hong Kong Intellectual Property Society.

Born and educated in Hong Kong, Sin Chung Kai holds a Bachelor of Science degree from the University of Hong Kong and, a Master of Business Administration degree from the Chinese University of Hong Kong.

Mr. Mok is the President of the Hong Kong Information Technology Federation, and the immediate past Chairman of the Hong Kong Internet Service Providers Association. He is also a member of many government advisory bodies, including the Consumer Council, Information Infrastructure Advisory Committee, and Trade and Industry Advisory Board. He is a director of Hong Kong Internet Registration Corporation. He was also a former part-time member of the Central Policy Unit. He was also an elected member of the First and Second Election Committee for the Legislative Council, IT Subsector. As one of the founders of Hong Kong's Internet business, Mr. Mok has taken an active role in the information technology industry.

Mr. Mok is the Chief Executive Officer of Halo Systems Limited. Halo Systems is one of Hong Kong's leading information technology solution and service provider with businesses software system development, IT consulting and outsourcing, supply chain management solutions, mobile and e-commerce applications, personal computer system manufacturing, and computer product trading and sales. Halo Systems is the technology flagship of Celestial Asia Securities Holdings Limited, a new type of conglomerate that, using common technology and brand platform, can create synergies and economies of scale through bringing together businesses serving different segment of the consumer market.

Previously, Mr. Mok was a co-founder of HKNet and successfully developed the company into a leading regional ISP and next-generation telecom operator. HKNet was acquired by NTT Communications in 1999. Mr. Mok graduated from Purdue University with Bachelor and Master Degrees in Electrical Engineering. Previously, he was with SunSoft Inc. and Digital Equipment Corporation in the United States. In 1999, he was elected as one of Hong Kong's "Ten Outstanding Young Digi Persons", as a testament to his continuous contribution to the industry.
